

Fiftieth Year Observance

Three Lutheran churches of Salem will participate in the observance of the 50th anniversary of the Pacific Synod of the United Lutheran Church in America, which is to be held in Portland, Monday through Friday of next week, Sept. 24-29. The three churches from Salem participating in the observance will be Faith, Good Shepherd and St. Mark.

Speakers at the important occasion will be Dr. J. Allen Leas of Chicago, one of the organizers of the Pacific Synod; Dr. P. W. H. Frederik of Fremont, Neb., one of the early presidents of the Pacific Synod; and Dr. John L. Sawyer of Vancouver, B. C., the former president of the Pacific Synod. Dr. Walter I. Eck, who has been the secretary of the Pacific Synod for over 30 years, will be in charge of the anniversary observance.

On Saturday evening, Sept. 29, the Synodical Brotherhood convention of the Pacific Synod will meet at St. James Lutheran church of Portland. Ralph J. Wohlsen of Bridgeport, Conn., president of the brotherhood of the ULCA will be guest speaker. The convention theme is "500 in '51." The goal of the convention is to have 500 laymen of the Pacific Synod at the meeting.

Unitarians to Hear Peterman

The Rev. Sidney Peterman, minister to the Eugene Unitarian church, will be the guest speaker at the Salem Unitarian fellowship meeting at 8 p.m. Sunday, in the Salem Memorial hospital chapel.

The fellowship is sponsoring a series of three public meetings on Unitarianism and liberal religion. The series will explain the principles and faith of the church, the role that the Unitarians have played in the development of the democratic principle, and why the faith is important today.

Rev. Peterman will speak on "What is Unitarianism?" The following Sunday, David Dunaway, state archivist, will speak on "Who Are These Unitarians?" The last in the series will be "Why Unitarianism?" with the speaker to be announced at a later date.
