

Blue, Wallowa Mountains of Rugged Beauty

The Interesting Blue and Wallowa mountains of north-eastern Oregon are a never-ending source of scenic wonder and glorious recreation.

The Blue mountains extend from the north-eastern part of Grant county and western Baker county to the northern part of Wallowa county in Oregon. The Wallows are a less extensive but equally beautiful rugged range in the southern part of Wallowa county and northern part of Baker county. Both the terrain surrounding the ranges and the peaks within them remind visitors of Alpine scenes viewed by many only in the movies and on picture post cards.

Much of this scenery, however, is easily accessible via Oregon's U.S. highway 30 and state highways 82 and 204 out of Pendleton and LaGrande. One of Oregon's most scenic trips is over these highways from Pendleton to Wallowa lake near Joseph.

From Pendleton, the home of the famous Round-Up, the motorist may take U.S. 30. Emigrant Hill to the southeast offers a breathtaking panorama of the checkerboard grainlands of the huge Umatilla river basin and immediately south of the mountain, the motorist will begin to enter the pine tree country of the Blue mountains.

Perhaps one of the first stops will be at Emigrant Springs State park where the visitor may eat his picnic lunch, cook at rustic fireplaces and enjoy the cool shade of majestic pine groves. Much of the route along here is within the Umatilla National forest and over the Old Oregon Trail. He will also pass the Blue Mountain Forest Wayside and Gangloff State Park near LaGrande.

At LaGrande, a railroad center and agricultural community, the motorist may visit the campus of the Eastern Oregon College of Education. This city is the southern entry port to the Grande Ronde valley, and it is here that the motorist will change to state highway 82.

The Grande Ronde valley, and the river of that name, extend northeastward. The valley is one of checkered grain and seed lands. At Rhinehart, the motorist will begin to parallel and cross the river twice before entering Elgin. This city is a year-around recreation center. Hunting, fishing, hiking, swimming and skiing are available from here in season. It is only 21 miles south of the Tollgate-Spout Springs recreational and winter sports area.

At Elgin the motorist will turn almost in an easterly direction and begin to climb. At Minam he will cross the Wallowa.

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
