

Five Held for Bank Robbery

Oak Harbor, Wash. (AP)—Three men and two women were charged with robbery and first degree burglary Monday a few hours after the Langley State Bank at Langley was robbed of \$5,421.

Prosecutor Alden Whelan filed an information in Superior Court against Vernon T. Jenkins, 32, James R. Allen, 28, Jane Powell, Jane Doe and John Doe, all of Seattle.

Whelan said Jenkins and Allen were arrested at Coupeville about two hours after the robbery. Mrs. Powell, wife of a former Oak Harbor dentist, was taken into custody later in the day.

Search continued for the other two. Whelan said Mrs. Powell, operator of a Seattle real estate office, was implicated in the robbery by Jenkins and Allen. She denied any connection with the case.

Ralph S. Noble, president of the bank, said two men entered his home early Monday, beat him and forced him to accompany them to the bank.

Noble said the men took state liquor store and state ferry receipts turned in after the bank closed for the weekend. Time locks on the main vault prevented a larger haul, the bank official added.

Ice Harbor Drive Beaten

Washington (AP)—A closing-hour drive to obtain funds to start Ice Harbor Lock and Dam on the Snake river in Washington state met defeat as congress hastened to adjourn Monday.

However, senate leaders promised Sen. Magnuson (D., Wash.) who spearheaded the drive, they would try to get the money early in the 83rd congress.

The \$3,000,000 appropriation for Ice Harbor was linked with the debate over a \$4,000,000 item the senate had approved for the Hartwell dam on the Savannah river between South Carolina and Georgia.

The house eliminated both items from the rivers and harbors and flood control bill. Sens. Maybank (D., S.C.) and Olin Johnston (D., S.C.) had threatened to filibuster against the bill unless the Hartwell dam appropriation was restored.

They dropped the fight when the supplemental appropriation bill was amended to request the AEC to investigate the importance of the dam to the giant Savannah river atomic plant and submit a report to the next congress.

Senate leaders said they would try to get funds for the Hartwell dam and gave a similar promise to Magnuson who protested the house action on the Ice Harbor project.

Magnuson said the project was as important as the Hartwell dam because it would supply additional power for the atomic energy commission's atomic plant at Hanford, Wash.

Siletz Man Fatally Hurt at Newport

Newport, Ore. (AP)—Two trucks collided near here Monday fatally injuring the driver of one.

He was Harold Victor Emil Johansen, 47, of Siletz. Robert Luttrell, also of Siletz, the driver of the other truck, was not hurt.

The widow and five children survive.

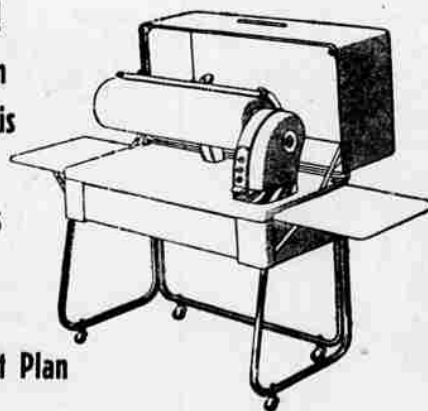
