Chief Sowa announced that he is leaving the department to enter private employment. The resignation also removes Chief Sowa as chief of the Woodburn rural fire protection district. The resignation becomes effective March 1.

ITINERANT HELD IN ALBANY DEATH

Oakland, Calif. (AP) — A 37-year-old itinerant was held here Thursday for Albany, Ore., authorities on a murder warrant in the death of Lot Hughes Gilmore, 56. John Bob Sturgill was arrested Wednesday at the home of his sister, Mrs. Josephine Tourchette at Russell City in southern Alameda county. He was traced by a letter he wrote to Oregon asking that his unemployment pay checks be forwarded to his sister's home. Sheriff George Miller of Albany said Sturgill was accused of clubbing Hughes to death in a fight during a drinking party at a hobo camp east of Albany. Gilmore's body was not found until Tuesday. By that time Sturgill had left.
