

## Plans Made for Leader Session

Plans were completed today for the leadership program to be sponsored by Willamette university Saturday, with the announcement of the keynote and luncheon speakers.

The morning session will be held in the state library with those in attendance moving to the capitol for the afternoon.

Otto J. Wilson, Salem business man, will launch the all day meeting with the keynote address at 9:30 on "Why Leadership." State Representative

R. L. Eitstrom will be luncheon guest speaker. His topic will be "Your Future With Leadership."

Senator Phil Hitchcock of Klamath Falls will be the featured speaker at the banquet Saturday night.

Following the keynote address, Peter Soderland, student body president of Southern Oregon College of Education, will give an insight into "What Is Leadership?" Audrey Daum, president of the Memorial Union at Oregon State, will give a talk on "Effective Types of Leadership."

The program has been designed to give students a working knowledge of the art of leadership.

## 10 Scholarships Made Available

Announcement of 10 \$1,000 Max D. Tucker scholarships available to students in Oregon was made Thursday by Dr. G. Herbert Smith, president of Willamette university and chairman of the directing committee. Information and applications have been sent to high school principals and counselors throughout the state.

Students who are granted these scholarships may attend Willamette, Lewis and Clark college, University of Oregon and Oregon State college.

Three scholarships are annually awarded in the school of forestry at O.S.C. and two un-

restricted scholarships are given yearly to each of the three participating institutions, with a third scholarship available each third year.

Qualifications for the scholarship stipulate that candidates must rank in the upper 10 per cent of their graduating class. Those students already in college must stand in the upper 20 per cent of their college class and candidates must be recommended by their schools on the basis of scholarship, loyalty and service. Qualities of leadership and character as well as financial need also will be important considerations.

Members of the Max D. Tucker scholarship committee, in addition to the chairman, are Dr. Morgan S. Odell, Lewis and Clark; Dr. Harry K. Newburn, University of Oregon and Dr. A. L. Strand, Oregon State college.
