

New Zoning Plan Mapped by City Commission

The map above shows how the city of Salem has been zoned by the new code recently made public. The permitted uses in the various zones are explained in the boxed legend in the upper left corner of the map. The map is preliminary and subject to changes. Public hearings will be held before the new code is finally adopted. The zones will be residential, business, industrial, and special use.
