

### Teachers to Attend Meet

A number of Salem educators will be in Portland next week to attend the sessions and take part in the deliberations of the 80th annual convention of the Oregon Education Association. The conference will take place in the Portland auditorium beginning Monday.

Salem schools will be suspended next week in connection with spring vacation. The period coincides with the Class A basketball tournament that opens in Eugene Tuesday.

### War Factories In China Boom

Tokyo (AP)—Two leftist Japanese just returned from Communist China said factories and plants are working full blast around the clock, factory hands are working in three shifts and production is being pushed to full capacity.

Mrs. Tomi Kora, leftist Socialist member of the Japanese Diet Parliament and her private secretary, Zenichi Sakurai, were members of the 13-member repatriation delegation which negotiated in Peiping for the return of 30,000 Japanese stranded in China since World War II. They said both men and women in Red China wear a pale blue cotton uniform—a style set by Red Boss Mao Tze-Tung. Girls and women do not use lipsticks or face powder.

The two Japanese were in Red China more than a month. Mrs. Kora recently visited the Soviet Union without permission of the Japanese government.
