are unnecessary, undemocratic, un-Christian and discriminatory. The bills would prohibit pick-eting in order to sign up em-

ployes, allow unions to be sued, and prevent strikes without a yote of the employes.

The labor leaders claimed the bills would cause more strikes, instead of curbing them.






