Killer Suspect Back for Trial

Albany — Arraigned in circuit court here Tuesday on a first degree murder indictment, John Bob Sturgill was given until Wednesday at 4 p.m. to plead, and Circuit Judge Victor Olliver appointed Sam Kyle to represent him as counsel.

Sturgill is under indictment here for first degree murder in connection with the killing of Lot Hughes Gilmore in an Albany jungle hobo camp in February.

Linn County Sheriff George Miller made two trips to California after Sturgill. Just before his arrival the first time, the accused man obtained a writ of habeas corpus, which held up his return to Oregon.

The Oregon authorities, Miller reports, were ready to make a showing in court. They had with them Sturgill's finger prints, taken in Albany only a few days before Gilmore was killed. Sturgill, in applying for the writ had denied ever having been in Albany. The court acted on motion of the district attorney of Alameda county, for lack of evidence supporting the writ.

Demos Agree to Let Morse Have Rear Seat

Washington (AP)—The Senate Democratic Policy committee agreed yesterday that Sen. Wayne L. Morse (Igd-Ore.) can sit on the Democratic side of the Senate "in the back row of the northwest corner."

Morse, who bolted the Republican party during the 1952 political campaign, wants to sit on the Democratic side. He said he was tired of overhearing some of the remarks of his former Republican colleagues.

Charge Hitch-Hikers With Radio Theft

Albany — A Halsey man, who Tuesday morning said he gave two Washington youths a ride from Halsey to Albany, complained to city police 15 minutes after he had arrived here that the two who had accepted the ride had stolen a radio from his car, Police Chief Ray Maddy said.

Ray Lucas told police he picked up two hitch-hikers and brought them to Albany. Lucas parked his car, returned to it a few minutes later and discovered the theft.

Police had the two youths under arrest in less than an hour after they had been notified.

Police charged that Kenneth Lester Freeman, 20 and Harold Henning Snell, 18, both of Hoquiam, Wash., took the radio from Lucas' car and sold it to Johnny's Furniture and Hardware, 304 E. Second Ave. for \$3. Employees of Johnny's identified the youths and Lucas identified his radio, police said.

They were to be tried in municipal court.

Grow Hair on Siamese Twin

Chicago (AP)—Rodney De Brodie, the head-joined Siamese twin who survived separation from his brother, may have a natural head of hair when he grows up.

The 18-month-old youngster appears improving after his 18th operation 10 days ago.

His scalp, built up of skin grafts from his own forehead contains sufficient hair follicles to provide regular trips to the barber shop as he grows older, says plastic surgeons at the University of Illinois Research and Educational hospital. They said he has come through the scalp-building process in good shape "cosmetically." There will be scars, but not very noticeable ones. He still wears his bandage like a little chef's cap.

Rodney's twin brother, Roger Lee, died about one month after the crucial operation which separated them last Dec. 17.
