

### Sailor Kills 2, North Bend

Coquille 420—A Puerto Rican ship's cook today faced two counts of first degree murder following a shooting spree that resulted in two dead and five wounded.

Florencio Martes Fuentes, 38, signed a statement admitting the shooting, Coos County District Attorney John J. Pickett said.

Police said Fuentes fired point blank at Mable Alice Pressnall, 25, North Bend, and Harold Edison Carter, 24, Houser, killing them both. Wounded were Mr. and Mrs. Glenn Pettit, both 27; Harvey Hargens, 24, all of North Bend, and two seamen, Amos Jones and John Patrick.

Fuentes, a crewman aboard the Weyerhaeuser lumber ship F. S. Bell, entered Ripper's Roundup room at North Bend about 11 p. m. Saturday night and emptied his gun into a crowd of patrons, police said. According to witnesses, Fuentes was in the club about an hour earlier and asked Mrs. Pressnall, divorced wife of a Portland policeman, to dance. She refused.

He returned to his ship and re-entered the club, walked to Mrs. Pressnall's table and blasted away at her and her escort. Then he fired into the crowd and raced into a storeroom to reload his .38 caliber pistol. He was overpowered by patrons.

### Einstein Offers New Relativity Theories

New York 420—Asbert Einstein has published new theories of relativity which he expects to become the master key to the physical makeup and operation of the universe.

The master scientist and mathematician considers his new conclusion the crowning achievement of his 74 years of life-conclusions that may eventually remove all mystery from fundamental laws governing the cosmos.

The work is the climax of 40 years of study, scientific deduction, and thinking by one of the world's most discerning brains.

The new Einstein theory is a development of his earlier known convictions that the material universe if composed of two major fields, the field of gravitation and the electromagnetic field.

His belief is that the physical universe is one continuous field, similar to an endless stream.

### Kills Crippled Son As Act of Mercy

Clifton, N. J. 420—An anguished father, fearing his own death was near, killed his crippled five-year-old son in what he told police was an "act of mercy."

Albert Bell, 44, a restaurant owner, faced arraignment today on a murder charge in the death of his son, Albert, Jr., a cerebral palsy victim.

Sell, a World War II veteran who underwent a major operation last January, said he shot and killed his son to keep him from "growing up helpless." He told police that he also feared he himself might die soon and he did not want the boy to become a burden on his ill wife.

### Roberts Calls GOP Meeting for April 10

Washington 420—Republican Chairman C. Wesley Roberts today called the GOP National Committee to meet here April 10 to choose his successor.

Roberts resigned under fire yesterday. He left the unprepared Eisenhower administration with an urgent repair job to perform on the party organization.

### Canadian Says Reds Hopped up with Opium

Toronto 420—A Halifax veteran fresh from the Korean front said today that Communist troops are so "hopped-up" with opium they can't shoot straight.

Pvt. Earl Jones, who made 17 trips behind enemy lines on reconnaissance patrols in a year, said Red troops were given opium rations before action, and prisoners were always found to be doped when taken. He said the opium is carried in a little three-ounce bag tied to the soldier's belt along with his rice.

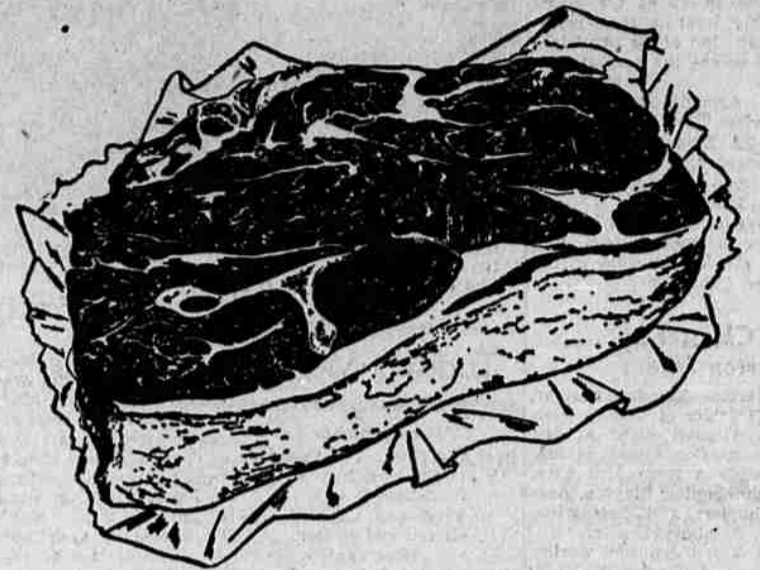
