

OSC to Call Stadium Bids

Portland (AP)—Oregon State college today was authorized to call for bids for its new stadium to seat 26,156 persons. The Building committee of the State Board of Higher Education announced the authorization at a meeting here yesterday.

In other action, the firm of Burns, Bear and McNeil was selected to draw plans for the crippled children's administration, an outpatient unit near the medical school. The building was authorized by the 1953 Legislature.

Also authorized was purchase of an 80-acre addition to McDonald forest north of Corvallis and expenditure of \$552,000 for 24 rehabilitation, repair and deferred maintenance projects on six campuses.

Herbert and Cain Confirmed

Washington (AP)—The Senate Tuesday confirmed former Gov. Thomas J. Herbert of Ohio and former Sen. Harry P. Cain of Washington as members of the Subversive Activities Control Board.

Majority Leader Taft of Ohio first won unanimous consent to temporarily put aside the controversial submerged lands bill to consider the nominations.

The five-member board was established by Congress to hear appeals by organizations and individuals listed as communist or sympathetic to communism. Members receive \$15,000 a year.

Taft said that Herbert, former Republican governor of Ohio, was eminently qualified and that Cain was a former Republican senator.

Cain's appointment is until Aug. 9 and that of Herbert until April 9 next year.

This Farmer Knew How To Get Even

Henryetta, Okla. (AP)—Harry Decker, an irate farmer, drove into the main part of town during the shopping hour Monday and before hundreds of startled onlookers dumped two gunny sacks of tin cans on the street.

Hauled before Mayor Wilson Fisher, who also serves as municipal judge, Decker explained the rubbish was a matter of give-and-take. He said he only was returning debris dumped on his farm by residents of the city.

Alaska May Get Special Session

Anchorage, Alaska (AP)—Territorial Gov. Frank Heintzleman says he is considering calling a special session of the Legislature but will make his decision after returning to Juneau.

The governor, in office less than a month, told Third Division legislators of his problems in a discussion here.

He said problems he faces include administration, change in legislation, housing and decrease in freight rates to attract venture capital.

U. S. Steel Declares Quarterly Dividend

New York (AP)—United States Steel Corp. reported net income for the first three months of 1953 was \$49,375,958, equal to \$1.65 a common share.

This compared with \$48,126,916, of \$1.60 a share, in the preceding period and with \$43,534,212, or \$1.43 a share, in the first quarter a year ago.

Directors declared a dividend of 75 cents a share on common stock, the same as in preceding quarters. It is payable June 10 to holders of record May 8.

Two Transports Arrive at Seattle

Seattle (AP)—Two transports docked here Monday with a total of 3,325 military and civilian passengers from the Far East.

The transport Marine Serpent brought 2,689 soldiers on rotation leave from Japan and Korea.

The 636 passengers aboard the Gen. Hugh J. Gaffey, which arrived two hours after the Marine Serpent, included 251 military dependents.
