Vice Consul Visitor Here

Norman R. Prickett, British vice-consul in Portland, was a Salem visitor Tuesday and Wednesday, and while here made contacts with the Chamber of Commerce and men connected with the industrial life of Salem.

The consular service, however, Mr. Prickett said, is not alone interested in industrial affairs. Men in the consular service have to be informed on many things, because of the great variety of questions asked them and the many problems presented by the public.

Information about visas, legal questions, money exchange and trade relations are just a few of the things in the routine day of a man in the consular service, according to Mr. Prickett. And he doesn't try to avoid them. Both British subjects and American citizens are invited to ask about anything they want information on. In industrial inquiries he said that more questions are asked of his office by Americans than by British subjects.

Mr. Prickett was transferred to Portland from the Seattle office the first of this year. The Portland office is in the Lewis building at SW Fourth and Oak.
