

Airforce Chief Retires, Twining Successor

Washington (P) — The White House announced Thursday Gen, Hoyt S. Vandenberg is retiring as Air Force chief of staff and will be succeeded by Gen. Nathan F. Twining.

Twinning at present is vice chief of staff. Assuming the Senate confirms his appointment, he will step up to the top Air Force post June 30, when Vandenberg's term expires.

This is the first change in the Joint Chiefs of Staff since Eisenhower took office, and the White House gave no indication whether it would be followed by other changes.
