Moeller Blasts Douglas McKay

Oregon Attorney General Robert Y. Thornton was called upon to use every effort in the court to block construction of the proposed Idaho Power company dam on Snake river in a statement issued today by Richard Moeller, president of the Oregon State Farmers Union.

Moeller's statement blasted Secretary of the Interior Douglas McKay for his decision to turn over the "immensely valuable hydroelectric sites on the Snake river to the Idaho Power company" and denounced his action as a "shocking betrayal of the public interest". Western farmers will pay \$15 a ton for more phosphate fertilizer as a result of McKay's action, Moeller's statement said.

"We must prepare to take the issue to the people in the 1954 elections and focus the attention of the people of the Northwest on the record of those senators and representatives in Congress who are participating in this give-away and grab" program, Moeller concluded.
