Wilson Pledges Airforce Hike

Washington 6/25 — Defense Secretary Charles E. Wilson said today that the administration's fiscal 1954 plans call for boosting the air force "30 per cent in numbers" and "more than that in combat effectiveness."

Wilson told a senate military appropriations subcommittee his department has set a goal of 120 air wings, with 114 of them well equipped and ready for combat by the end of the year starting July 1.

Democrats on the subcommittee quizzed him on what President Eisenhower's proposed \$2,300,000,000 cut in defense spending will do to the air force for which the Truman administration had set a goal of 143 wings.

Wilson assured them that the new defense budget will not curtail production of any modern planes that the air force can get "within reason." He stressed the necessity of getting modern planes into quantity production and perfected so that they are "right for the service."

Grange Will Protest McKay Dam Decision

Portland 6/26 — The Oregon State Grange will hold a "Snake River Resources Conference" to protest what it calls abandonment of the river to "self-seeking, exploitive groups."

Elmer McClure, state grange master, said yesterday that grange, civic, farm, labor and other groups from Oregon, Washington, Idaho and California were expected to attend the conference in Portland Saturday.

The Oregon grange has consistently favored construction of a federally-financed dam at Hells Canyon. McClure said the Eisenhower administration's policy favoring private dams at the site "is the end of comprehensive development on the Snake and the beginning of the end in the whole system."
