Facilities Improved At Silver Falls Park

Improved facilities have been installed at Silver Falls state park located about 26 miles from Salem and Wallawa Lake state park in northeastern Oregon were installed in 1952.

These provide tables, wood or electric stoves, laundry faellities, restrooms, showers and individual tent camps or

trailer camps with electric and waste water outlets.

During the past year a similar camp with 18 trailer and 32 tent sites was constructed at Emigrant Springs state park, 28 miles east of Pendleton and is ready for use in the 1953 season.

Norfolk Island, 400 miles northeast of New Zealand is one of the few spots discovered by European explorers which was previously uninhabited.
