Reservists Return From 2 Weeks Camp

Forty-six army reservists who were members of units from Salem returned to Salem Saturday night after two weeks of summer training at Fort Lewis, Wash.

The first bus load of men arrived at 7 p.m. Saturday with the second getting here at 9 p.m.

Two major events, besides the regular training were reported by the men on their return. First was August 31 when they had "Day in the Army Day" with visitors from various cities present and the second was the parade August 6.

Members of the instructor staff for the Salem outfits commented on their return that the Salem units were above average.

During their stay at the fort the men of the units of the 929th field artillery fired both sub-caliber and 105 mm machine guns and the 3.5 bazooka.

A recruit from McMinnville, Pvt. Robert Shangle, who was taking recruit training qualified as an expert in the M-1 rifle on the rifle range. He is a member of battery A, 929th.

Members of E company, 413th infantry regiment, also of Salem, did their firing with the 60 mm mortars.
