Ingredients: 1½ cups sifted
cake flour, 1½ teaspoons baking powder, ½ teaspoon sait, 3
eggs (separated and at room
temperature) % cup cold water, 1½ cups augar, 1½ teaspoons vanilla ¾ teaspoon
lemon extract, 1 cup heavy
eream (whipped), 1 pint cultivated blueberries.

Method: Line bottom of two 8 by 8 by 2 inch pans with waxed paper; grease paper. Sift flour, baking powder and salt together. Beat egg yolks and water until tripled in volume. Gradually beat in sugar. Continue to beat until light colored and thick enough to mound slightly — about 10 minutes. Stir in flavorings. Add flour mixture all at once; fold it in. Beat egg whites until stiff but not dry; fold into yolk mixture until blended. Pour into prepared pans. Bake in moderate (350 F.) oven 30 to 35 minutes or until done. Invert pars on cake rack until cake is cold. on cake rack until cake is cold.
