

Nut Growers Announce Tour

August 20-21 are the dates for the annual summer tour sponsored by the Nut Growers Society of Oregon and Washington. Thursday is "Walnut Day" and Friday is "Filbert Day", announces C. O. Rawlings, Corvallis, secretary-treasurer of the society.

Visitors are asked to provide their own lunches both days. Assembly time on Thursday, August 20, is 9:00 a.m. at the Pat Unger orchard, located about 2 1/2 miles northwest of Laurel and 5 miles southwest of Hillsboro.

Other stops on Thursday are scheduled for 10:30 a.m., Case Implement company, Newberg; 12 noon, basket lunch followed by a look at the John Trunk orchard, Dundee; 2:00 p.m., Chet Mulkey orchard, McMinnville, and 4:00 p.m., Oregon State college Lewis-Brown horticultural farm near Corvallis.

On Friday, the first stop at 9:00 a.m. is slated for the Gordon Weygandt and Son orchard, Canby. Assembly point is Weygandt's dryer a few blocks east from the blinker light in Canby. At 10:30 a.m., a stop is scheduled at F. A. Meagher's orchard located 3 miles south of Tualatin.

Following lunch at the Chesham school, a 1:00 p.m. stop is scheduled at the Carl Marnsch and Edward Johnson orchards northwest of Newberg. Other afternoon stops are 2:30 p.m., Glen Childs, Dayton, and 3:30 p.m., Lee H. Maloney, McMinnville.

Mt. Angel Herd Takes Honors

Milk production honors during July went to the C. J. Berning herd of Mt. Angel, according to records of the DHIA. Three Holsteins made over a ton of milk. No. 28 gave 2635 pounds of milk and 92.2 pounds of fat. No. 22 produced 2190 pounds of milk in 31 days and No. 55 was credited with 2120 pounds.

Joe Bilyeu and Harley McCammon, DHIA supervisors, report 49 Marion county standard herds produced 1.3 million pounds of milk and 30 tons of butterfat. Good dairy pastures are credited with assistance in making high productions possible.

High butterfat cow during July was Herb Coleman's Jersey Nixie at Woodburn. She gave 1500 pounds of milk and 97.5 pounds of fat.

I. F. Buserie and Son's Jersey, Laura, at Woodburn, produced 1497 pounds of milk and 94.3 pounds of milk.

When the check reached the bank, three others of identical amount with the doctor's name forged on them came in from various taverns and cafes.

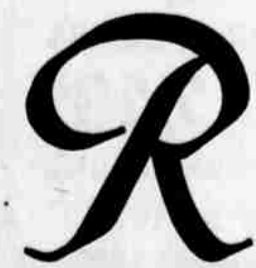
The man apparently cashed the checks and fled town, police said, after checking his known hangouts.
