Rates on some types of automobile insurance in Oregon would be boosted 4 to 5 per cent under a schedule filed with the state insurance commissioner by the National Automobile Underwriters association, Commissioner Robert B. Taylor said today. Public liability and property

damage would not be affected, but comprehensive coverage for fire and theft would go up if the schedule is approved.

been with the regular Army since 1920, is to be honored August 28 at a reception to be given at the Vancouver Barracks club, with several from this area invited to attend.

RED NAVY BUSY

Tokyo, (AP) — The Japanese press reported Thursday the Soviet Union has stepped up naval activities in the waters near Hokkaido, Japan's northernmost main island. The lighthouse at Cape Soya, 30 miles from Russian Sakhalin, reported observing three 7,000-ton class Soviet warships cruising toward Sakhalin.
