

# Portland, Seattle Divide Sunday's Doubleheader

(By The Associated Press) Boasting a 5-2 bulge in their final home stand with the Portland Beavers, the improving Seattle Rainiers will try for victory No. 6 in the wrapup game of their Pacific Coast League series Monday night with Steve Navy throwing against the Beavers' Royce Lint.

The game at Seattle, will make up for the contest washed out by Saturday night's rainstorm. It will be the final meeting of the year between the longtime PCL rivals.

The clubs divided Sunday's doubleheader, Seattle winning the opener 4-2, then losing the nightcap 3-0. First place Hollywood and Oakland also split, 9-5 and 0-3, and the Stars remained 9 1/2 games in front of the Rainiers.

Catcher Ray Orteig was Seattle's margin over Portland in Sunday's opener. His homer in the sixth gave the Rainiers a 3-1 lead and broke up a pitcher's duel between Seattle's Bill Evans and Portland's Jehoshe Heard.

In other games, San Diego copped a pair from Sacramento 6-4 and 4-2; and Los Angeles nipped San Francisco 5-4, then was clubbed 8-2.

In the only other game on the PCL front Monday night, Los Angeles and Hollywood square off in their last city series. Fights, fines and furore accompanied the last meeting between the two but the clubs have been warned against a repetition in Monday night's clash.

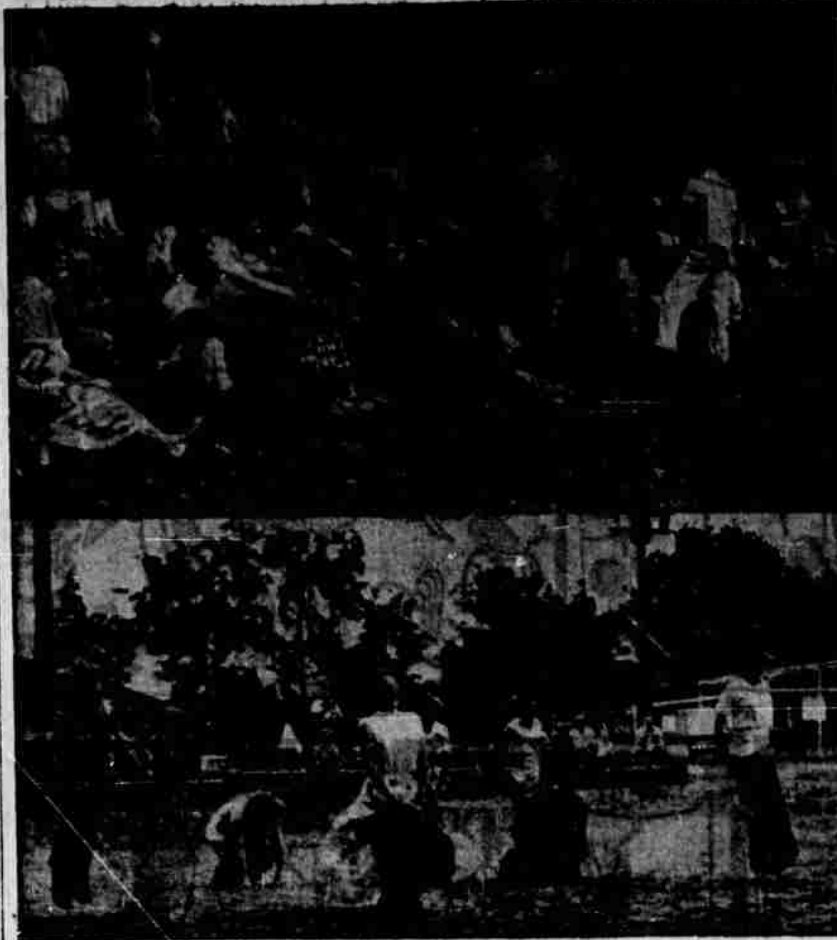

# 7 Killed in Accidents Over the Week-End

(By The Associated Press) Accidents claimed the lives of seven from Oregon over the week-end. Three were killed and seven were injured in one automobile collision. Two other traffic accidents, a tractor mishap and a boating accident were blamed for the other deaths.

Witnesses of the phenomena were John Wiens, his daughter, Joanne, 10, and son, Loren, 17.

Mr. Wiens said that when he first noticed the saucerlike objects, one was flying on each side of the plane at a considerable distance.

Occasionally, he said, one of the objects would maneuver at tremendous speed to a point above the plane, then swoop back to its position alongside at a distance of 400 or 500 feet.

Within a very few minutes, according to Wiens, the plane and its ghostly es-

ort disappeared in the direction of Portland.

Wiens lives on Perrydale road, near Perrydale. The report was forwarded to the U.S. Filter Center at Portland.
