Bids Asked on Alcohol Plant

Springfield, Ore. (AP)—The General Services Administration Wednesday advertised for bids for disposal of the federal surplus alcohol plant at Springfield.

Bids will be received until Nov. 10 under three preferences — for production of alcohol or other products, for removal of equipment to other locations for use of purchasers, and for removal and resale of machinery and materials.

The plant was built during the war to convert wood waste to alcohol. In 1946, it was operated by the Willamette Valley Wood Chemical Co., but was turned back to the government in 1947 because it could not be operated economically.
