

Final Search for Day Gets Under Way

Oregon City (AP)—The final search for Ralph Day, missing for six days in the brush covered Wolf Camp area near Mount Hood, got underway Saturday.

Between 250 and 500 men were expected to comb the area Saturday and Sunday where Day, 60, disappeared while picking wild berries with his family.

Little hope is held that the Portland businessman will be found alive.

Arkansas Man In Fatal Accident

Ontario, Ore. (AP)—Injuries suffered in an automobile accident near here claimed the life Friday of Vivian T. Smith, 67, acting president of College of the Ozarks at Clarksville, Ark.

He was driver of a car which crashed into the rear of a truck on Highway 26 north of near-by Vale, state police reported.

His wife, a passenger, suffered a leg fracture and was brought to a hospital here.

MILLMAN KILLED

Cottage Grove (AP)—Vernon Hartwig, 34, an employee of the Anlauf Lumber Co., here was fatally injured in a mill accident Friday. He died en route to a hospital.

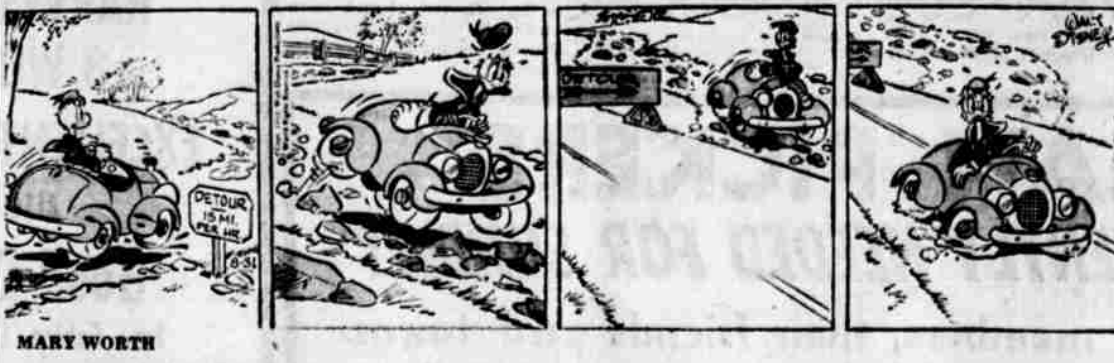
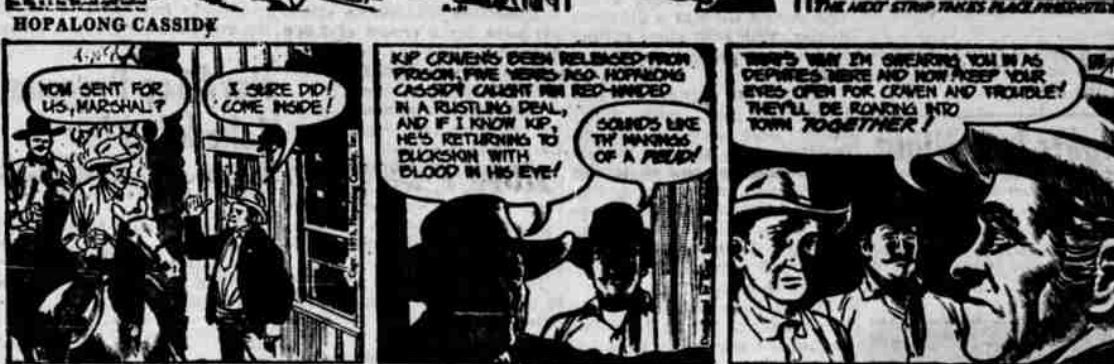
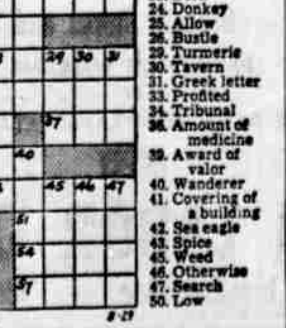
