

Wage Earning Report Made

More than four in five "regular" workers in construction and lumbering earned more than \$3,000 in 1952, according to tabulations just completed by the State Unemployment Compensation Commission.

Of the 18,070 employees of construction firms who worked in all four quarters last year, 14,730 or 81.5 per cent were paid at a rate in excess of \$250 a month, while for lumber and logging concerns the proportion was even higher with 82.8 per cent of the 71,380 regular workers in the \$3,000 class.

Other main groups who reported a higher proportion of regular workers in the over-\$3,000 group than the 69.1 per cent over-all estimate included transportation and warehousing with 79.5 per cent; wholesale trade 77.2 per cent; miscellaneous manufacturing 76.4 per cent; and communications and utilities with 72.5 per cent.

The utility group, however led all industries in the proportion of all workers who earned upwards of \$250 a month. Almost half (49.9%) of the 18,610 employees reported. Utilities also led in the proportion of "regular" workers with 68.5 per cent being paid in every quarter. Miscellaneous manufacturing and wholesale trade were next with 47.6 and 47.1 per cent respectively. Only 18.5 per cent of the food processing employees worked throughout the year.

Highest median pay for all workers (\$2,980) also was reported from the communications and utility group. Others over the \$200-a-month average for all employees reported included miscellaneous manufacturing \$2,855; wholesale trade \$2,823; lumber and wood products \$2,707; ship repairing \$2,696; and transportation and warehousing \$2,450.

In other groups, such as retail trade, the median for all employees has more than tripled in nine years—up from \$317 to \$1,014. Canning and preserving plants gradually came up from \$110 to \$390, while other food processing went from \$653 to \$2,064 in the same period. Finance and realty have more than doubled—from \$1,043 in 1943 to \$2,198 last year, and service workers have gained from \$414 to \$901.

Meteorite Suspect In Labrador Crater

Washington (AP)—The National Geographic Society says a crater discovered in the wilds of northern Labrador may have been dug by a big meteorite.

The society said some geologists think the pit may go back 3,000 to 15,000 years to the time when a large meteorite probably plunged through the earth's atmosphere and buried itself on Quebec's Ungava Peninsula to form Chubb Crater.

The newly-found crater is 185 yards in diameter and contains a round lake whose waters are apple green.

Dr. Victor Ben Meen, director of Toronto's Royal Ontario Museum, reached the new crater by air last week.
