Washington U.S - Fifteen Air Force B47 Stratojet bombers will sweep over Dayton, O., for the National Air Show tomorrow in a brief de-tour on a flight from England to Florida.

The Air Force said it will be the longest nonstop opera-tional jet training flight on record. The planes will re-fuel in the air from KC97 flying tankers.

The Stratojets, the world's fastest medium bombers, will average about 435 miles per hour on the 11½ hour, 5000mile flight.
