In lively competition for over nine million board feet of Bureau of Land Management timber in Lobster Valley, 174 bids were made before the Philomath Lumber company succeeded in topping offers of the Yew Creek Logging company of Corvallis at an oral auction sale conducted by Salem District Forester Rodney O. 
