Department Stores Sales Less in August

San Francisco (AP)—Department store sales in the Portland, Seattle and Spokane slipped in August, reflecting a national trend, the Federal Reserve Bank of San Francisco reported Tuesday.

The last week of the month was poorest, with a 9 per cent drop in sales over the nation. The decline for the month as a whole was 2 per cent.

In the Northwest, August sales were down 6 per cent in the Portland area, 5 per cent in the Seattle area and four per cent in the Spokane area as compared with August, 1952.


