## Time Needed To Clean Mess

Albany—Adverse criticism of the Eisenhower administration by the Democrats was to be expected from the start, as a matter of political routine, but as a matter of fact "I am surprised to find so many people who expected that the tangles left behind by the previous administration could be quickly unmeshed," Congressman Harris Ellsworth said yesterday in addressing this week's meeting of the Albany Kiwanis club.  
The fourth district representative in congress noted that President Eisenhower has been in office only ten months, and asserted that in that comparatively brief period the Republican administration has no reason to be ashamed of its record, particularly in view of the problems it inherited.  
President Eisenhower was bequeathed, for example, an enormous national debt, a shooting war in Korea, a two-year period of farm price de-

clines, attended by a rising general price level; a sorely troubled Europe, an inflated budget and a painful federal tax.
