OK Rails Cut on Oil Freight Rate

Washington (AP)—The Interstate Commerce Commission Friday authorized railroads operating in the Pacific Northwest to cut their freight rates on petroleum products to meet pipeline, trucking and barge competition.

The reductions were proposed by the carriers last January for hauls between points in Oregon, Washington, Wyoming, Idaho and Montana. However, the plan was held up by the ICC because of protests from competing forms of transportation.

Friday's decision to allow the cuts said that the railroads could not adequately compete for the petroleum traffic at their present rate levels.

The proposed new basic scale of charges will begin at 7 cents per 100 pounds for 10 miles or less, and progress upward for distances up to 1,200 miles.
