Case Delayed so Accused Pair May Consult Lawyer

Two young Seattle men, charged with the burglary of the St. Paul Market and Copeland Lumber Company store in St. Paul the night of November 17, appeared in Marion county district court on the charge Monday morning after being returned here Saturday by Oregon state police.

Some \$2,350 worth of liquor, cigarettes, power and hand tools were taken from the stores. The liquor was taken from the state liquor agency in the market.

None of the loot was recovered, police said. The men admitted in signed statements selling the liquor for \$1,100, they reported.

The two officers also brought back Jorge Navarro Santos, 31, Portland, on an assault and robbery charge for which he was arrested in Seattle recently on a Marion county district court warrant.

Santos is accused of participating in the beating and robbing of aged Louis Credito of the sum of \$73 last May near St. Paul. The other person accused in the case, Jesse Jack Friend, Tracy, California, was arrested on June 26 and was later released on his own recognizance when the complaining witness was unavailable for the trial.
