SKEWERED LAMB

Ingredients: 1 small onion, 1/2 teaspoon salt, freshly-ground pepper (to taste), 1/4 teaspoon dried crushed oregano, 1 to 1 1/4 pounds lean boneless lamb (cut in about 1-inch cubes), small onion wedges, squares of green pepper.

Method: Grate onion fine; mix onion pulp and juice with salt, pepper and oregano. Roll lamb in onion mixture; put in tightly covered jar and refrigerate overnight. At serving time, arrange lamb cubes on skewers alternately with onion wedges and green pepper squares. Broil until meat is cooked through but onion is still partly crisp. Makes 4 servings.

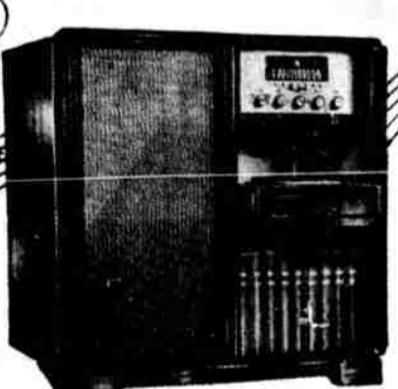

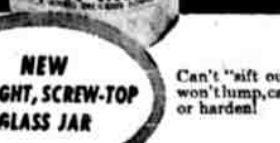
