

2 Appointed to Count Population in County

Mrs. Opal L. Nieswander of Salem and Robert H. Treupfel of Woodburn have been appointed enumerators for the current population survey in this area under the United States Bureau of the Census.

The bureau has been conducting a sample survey of retail trade in the area since February, and this month is beginning a collection of the data for the population survey, according to Guy E. Rainboth, supervisor of the bureau's district office in Seattle.

The current population survey, conducted for more than a decade by the Census Bureau, provides up-to-date national information about the numbers of persons who are employed and unemployed; the number of persons who are in school, retired or unable to

work; the availability of manpower for both defense and civilian production; and similar facts. Industry, labor and government are constantly using this information in planning various kinds of programs and in measuring the general level of business activity.

Rainboth pointed out that the current population survey is authorized by law. This law provides that all information about individuals be kept in strict confidence and that only statistical totals be published. Information obtained in the current population survey cannot be used for taxation, investigation or regulation.
