No doubt about it. Folks will be dropping in throughout the afternoon and evening on New Year's day and it will be well to plan something something refreshing that involves little work and not much fussing at the table. So, here is a good spiced fruit punch with New Year's atmosphere created by "clock" cookies. And if you've got "clock" cookies, it's only natural that she should preside at the punch (or coffee or tea table) and that small daughters of family should "assist."

We put numerals 1-9-5 and on part of our cookies "for offering" for fun. Do not attempt, however to put "1954" on any one cookie.

Spiced Fruit Punch

Of course this is very good New Year's Eve as well for New Year's Day. Recipe makes 3 1/2 quarts or punch cups.

2 cups boiling water
2 tea bags
1 2-inch stick whole cinnamon
2 cups fresh orange juice
2 teaspoons grated lemon rind
1 cup fresh lemon juice
1 teaspoon ground nutmeg
1 teaspoon ground allspice
1 cup sugar
1 tablespoon honey
Cracked ice
2 quarts gingerale

Combine water, tea and whole spices. Steep about 5 minutes. Remove tea bags and tea. Add next 8 ingredients. Strain over cracked ice in punch bowl and add gingerale. Serve at once. If desired, 3/4 cup grape juice may be added to make a dark punch and change flavor slightly. Garnish bowl with slices of orange and clusters of grapes. Makes 3 1/2 quarts or 28 punch cups. Double at your pleasure.

Keep this recipe at hand for using if you happen to have a lot of fruit cake on hand for offering with the New Year's punch. We made one obviously as a base for the clock and year numerals.



1 cup sugar
1 egg
2 tablespoons milk

Spiced Chocolate Cookies

Omit ginger in above recipe and increase cinnamon to 3/4 teaspoon. Use the same amount of cloves, 1/2 teaspoon. Mix 3 squares melted, unsweetened chocolate with butter or margarine when sugar is added.

To Make Lettering

Make numerals 1 to 12 on cookies with a stiff chocolate confectioners' sugar and egg white icing forced through a decorator's tube. Use any

left-over icing on other cookies. Arrange cookies on a large plate to resemble face of clock. Make clock hands from Spiced Chocolate Cookie Dough. Outline face of clock with chocolate cookies. As suggested earlier, we lettered 1-9-5-4 on cookies for passing.

After pork chops are browned in hot fat, pour a cup of marmalade over them and bake in a covered dish.
