MIAMI, Fla. (AP)—A part-time post office employee was reported in satisfactory condition in Veterans Administration hospital today after a kitchen knife was removed from his brain.

Authorities at Monroe General Hospital in Key West said Joseph W. Linder, 31, mutilated his face and then thrust the knife into his brain.

Key West police said Linder had written in a diary dated Jan. 3: "Now is the time to go to heaven, so let's go. One, two, three. Come on, Satan, if you want to wrestle with me."

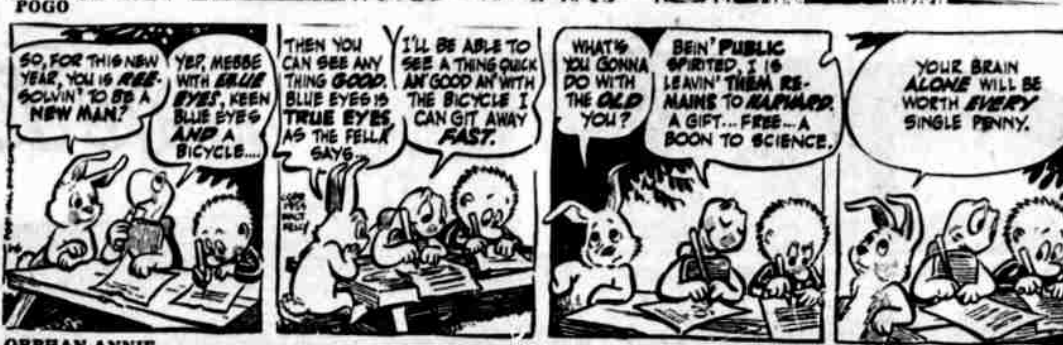

Petrillo Halts Chorus line

BOSTON (AP)—The pretty chorus line swung onto the night club floor last night and the band stopped playing abruptly.

Who stopped the music? President James C. Petrillo of the AFL American Federation of Musicians.

Why? Because the girls in the line belong to the American Guild of Vaudeville Artists, also AFL.

Petrillo was quoted as saying AGVA broke a union agreement by working with nonunion members. He ordered his members not to play for AGVA acts.

Union spokesmen said the hassle may spread from Boston's night clubs throughout the country.

Jury Dismissed; Not a Single Case

TILDEN, Tex. (AP)—At 10 a. m. yesterday Dist. Judge W. G. Gayle empaneled the grand jury, charged the 12 men to the grand jury courtroom. Then he swore in the petit jury for the week.

He called for the civil docket, but no cases were listed.

The grand jury foreman reported: "We know of no violation of criminal laws in McMullen County in the past six months. We therefore ask the grand jury be dismissed."

Judge Gayle dismissed the grand jury, the petit jury, complimenting the county on its law-abiding citizenship and went home to Beeville.

3 State Highways Now Closed by Snow

SALEM (AP)—There are possible minor delays because of construction on the Oregon Coast Highway three miles north of Gardiner and three miles south of Port Orford, the Highway Commission said Monday.

The commission's report also listed the McKenzie, Mt. Hood Loop and West Diamond Lake Highways as closed by snow.

There are five short sections of gravel surface on the Willamette Highway between Lowell and Odell Lake.

Construction two miles west of Jacksonville on the Medford-Provoigt highway is causing minor delays.
