

CD Short Wave Tops Report

Commencement of the last phase of the three year program to provide an adequate short wave radio emergency communication net for Civil Defense and the cooperating local Civil Defense units was the outstanding achievement during the six months period ending December 31, of the Marion County Civil Defense, Wallace W. Wharton, director, points out in his semi-annual report to the County Court.

Among other achievements of the period were improvement of the fire defense organization; development of plans for a series of home nursing classes in 1954; revision of the disaster action plan and payment by all but two of the cooperating cities of their allocated costs of the organization. It is anticipated that the short wave disaster communications system of the Marion County Civil Defense will be operative about mid-1954. When completed the system will consist of the Salem police net, parent net of the entire organization; the Marion County sheriff's net, now in operation, and the inter-city net.

"Development of the system is an outstanding example of community cooperation in Civil Defense preparedness," says Wharton in his report.

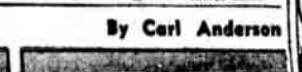
