Nimitz was here to personally award tonight the Nimitz trophy for the best all-around Navy reserve submarine division in the U. S. to Portland submarine division 13-7.

Nimitz said his order came during World War II when the Oregon was to be sunk at Guam to form a breakwater. Instead, it was used as a storage ship for

The battleship was left at Guam after World War II.

## **Farm Price Supports** No Prosperity Measure

WASHINGTON of — The Eisenhower administration, in advocating a farm program built on flexible price supports, seeks to dispel a common belief that prices afford an accurate measure of agricultural prosperity.

Flexible price guarantees—which would move up and down with price changes in supply of major crops—have been on lawbooks since 1948 but Congress has never allowed them to operate.
