New Orders on Sheridan Dates

WASHINGTON is. — The State Department said Wednesday it has sent new instructions to Panmunjom on whether the United States should insist on a retraction of Red China's charge of "perfidy."

Special ambassador Arthur H. Dean walked out of preliminary talks on a Korea peace conference last Dec. 12 in protest against the Communist accusation. He said then he would not return until the Communist took back the charge. However, new talks have been scheduled to set a date for reopening these broken-off preliminaries. Kenneth Young.
