

Date Centennial For Rock Creek

WOODBURN—The annual meeting of the Rock Creek Cemetery association was held Jan. 16. Officers elected were Lucius I. Simpkins, trustee to fill the vacancy caused by the death of Gilbert Noe; A. F. Frederickson was elected secretary-treasurer and A. C. Stuewe was elected caretaker for the coming year.

Plans were discussed for the fourth annual pioneer day to be held July 18, 1954. It will be the centennial of the Rock Creek Methodist church which was organized in 1854.

The usual morning church service will be held at 11 o'clock. Rev. Yarnes of Newberg has been invited to have charge. Mrs. Ted Landsem of Molalla will sing and Mrs. Marilyn Frick of Silverton will give violin selections.

One long table will be constructed for the lunch which will be pot luck with coffee furnished. A get-together will be held under the trees about 2 p.m. to honor the pioneers, and it is hoped to secure orchestral or band music for the afternoon.

Thirty life members and 19 regular members have been signed up by the association. All labor or the church and grounds is donated in an effort to reach a goal of \$5000 in a sinking fund. Cash on hand Dec. 31, 1953 was \$1989.43 and the slogan adopted is "Forty More in Fifty-Four."

Factors Listed For Seed Crops

"Three factors: production, supply, and use, establish the market situation for field seed crops," Ray Teal, Oregon State College Seed Marketing Specialist, told 160 seed growers at Marion County seed meeting at the Waldo Hills Community Clubhouse.

Teal continued by explaining that, generally speaking, two of the three factors are favorable for seed growers at present. "Seed production was down from the 1952 crop for 13 of the 15 major seed crops. Greater use for seed crops may be brought about by such conditions as the southern drought and crop acreage controls.

On the pessimistic side of seed production is the carry over of seed supplies. Harold Finnell, certification specialist at the college, reviewed the need and procedure of crop certification. Merion bluegrass and Kenland red clover are under the generation plan of seed certification where registered, foundation, or breeder's seedstock is required to certify the field. Just ordinary certified seedstock will not qualify to produce certified seed of these particular crops.

Deadline Fixed on Federal Crop Loans

Deadline for Marion county farmers to apply for government loans on the 1953 crop still on hand is January 29. Ed Dyck, at the ASC office, 440 North Church street, in Salem, is in charge of loans. He can be reached by phoning 2-7819.
