

Officers Fire on Man by Mistake

SAN FRANCISCO (AP) - A former Chinese vice consul here, running to his automobile to take his two daughters to school, was fired on by mistake Thursday night by police and federal narcotics agents making a raid.

Six bullets struck C. C. Lee's car but neither he nor his daughters, Mary 11, and Laura 9 was hurt.

Thoroughly frightened, Lee, a 38 year old insurance broker, sped away, found a policeman, and reported.

The raiders - two policemen and three federal agents - apologized.

Canadian Trucker Included in Law

WASHINGTON (AP) - Legislation designed to make Canadian truckers using United States highways conform to this country's safety and public liability laws was prepared Friday.

Rep. Bennett (R-Mich), one of the sponsors, said the Interstate Commerce Commission told him there is a need for the bill and that it would affect "thousands" of Canadian truckers.
