

Rudy Meffert On OSEA Staff

Rudy Meffert, who for the past year has been employed in the motor permit section of the Public Utilities Commissioner's office, will join the Oregon State Employees Association on February 1. Forrest Stewart, executive secretary announced Monday.

Meffert's duties with the association will include handling of employee grievances, gathering statistical data regarding personnel operations from private firms, and assisting in the general operation of OSEA.

Originally from the east where he attended school and later was employed in various capacities by eastern banks. He spent two years in Europe as representative for an investment firm.

In 1942 he enlisted in the Marines and served in the Pacific theatre. On his return to the United States Meffert was assigned to set up personnel and discharge procedure at Staff Headquarters in San Francisco, where he was discharged in 1946.

Electing to remain in the west he held appointments with two federal agencies as a traveling auditor in the Rocky Mountain and Coastal area. While employed in Salem he has been an active member of OSEA, Williams Chapter No. 21, serving as chairman of the Retirement committee and delegate to the 1952 general council. He was elected director of District 2 last fall.

Meffert is a member of American Legion Post 336, Salem, and a Past Noble Grand of the Odd Fellows. Both he and his wife are active members of the Salem bowling fraternity. His wife is native of Bend. They have one daughter.

The addition of Meffert increases the staff of OSEA to six.

MARION — Additional applications for the position of postmaster at Marion, Ore., have been requested by the U. S. Civil Service Commission at Washington, D.C.

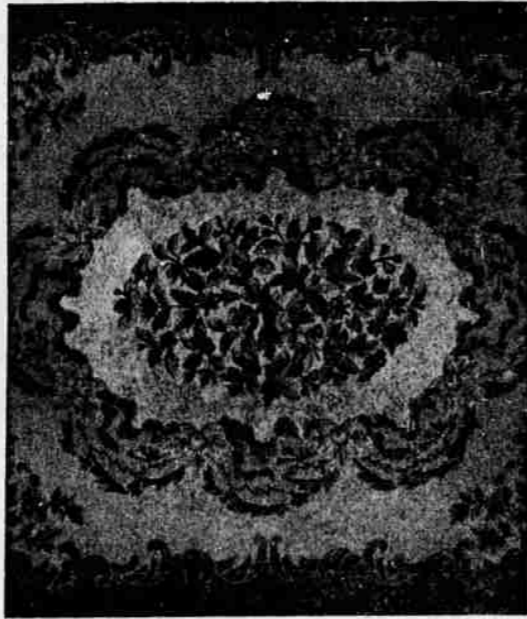
The commission reports that sufficient applications have not been received to assure adequate competition.

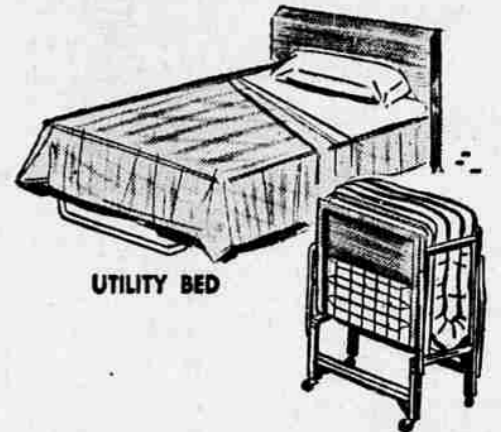
