**Speaker Fights Oregon Reds**

Mrs. Louise Gronnert, present secretary and Americanism chairman of American Legion Auxiliary Unit 1, Portland, will speak for Salem Post 136, American Legion, Tuesday night. The topic of her speech will be "They Smear Their Enemies". Mrs. Gronnert is particularly well qualified to speak on the subject and for the past five years she has been research specialist on subversive activities giving her full time to studying research on local, state and national levels. She has attended hundreds of meetings where Communist infiltration has been in operation in civic groups and women's organizations. She has gone to meetings of the hard-core Communist and has covered the hearings of immigration department dealing with aliens suspected of Communist membership.

Her knowledge is first hand and gained from her own experience while watching the machinations of Communist agents in Oregon. She is a constant follower of the Congressional Record and has carefully read all congressional committee reports until the present time, including the reports of Senator McCarthy. She has been and is now an ardent opponent of any who would change our form of government from that now represented by our present Constitution and representative government.

Salem Post 136 of the American Legion desires that the Women's club groups and organizations of Salem avail themselves of this opportunity, particularly the Women's Clubs, League of Women Voters, Garden Clubs and Business and Professional Women's Groups in order that they may understand and recognize Communist activity when and if it should ever appear.

The meeting will be held at the Isaac Walton League Building, 500 South Cottage, at 8 p.m. January 26.

**Federal Aid to 4 Airports in Oregon**

Federal aid in airport projects was given four airports in the state of Oregon during fiscal year 1953.

The projects are listed in the eighth annual report of operations under the federal airport act, issued recently by the civil aeronautics administration. Total amount allotted under the program for the United States and territorial possession was \$11,750,000 with \$11,075,000 available for projects within the continental limits and the remainder for airport development in the territories.

Oregon's share of this amount was \$270,704. The four projects in the state, their location and the federal funds allotted were:

Cave Junction, Illinois Valley, construction of runway, apron and taxiway, \$20,000; Medford municipal airport, enlarge apron and entrance road, install beacon

and install drainage, \$32,234; Pendleton airport, construction of sewage system, \$1,324, and construction of stabilize apron and automobile parking area, \$9,221; and Portland international airport, acquire additional land, \$207,825.

**Grid Hearing Set Tonight**

Salem people, including a strong bloc of business men, who are trying to abolish the present one-way grid system, expect to carry the fight to the ballot by way of an initiative petition.

The Salem City Council has called a public hearing on the question for tonight (Monday), but A. R. Melford, chairman of the Citizens' Committee for a Reasonable One-way Grid, says that "judging from the Council's attitude, I think we will have to go to the initiative."

He said indications were the council would not be swayed by the informal petitions signed by a couple of thousand persons.

Date for the hearing Monday night was set at the regular City Council meeting a week ago. The time will be 7:30 in the Council chamber at City Hall, and anyone can have his or her say on the controversial subject.

Both sides have thoroughly marshaled their arguments and it is expected the hearing will be long and snappy, with a large number of speakers on both sides.
