Copco Gets 50 Year License
 WASHINGTON (AP) — The Power Commission Thursday issued a 50-year license to the California Oregon Power Co., Yreka, Calif., for a hydro electric project on the Klamath River in Oregon, provided the company can obtain an agreement for continued use of water storage by an upstream federal reclamation dam.
 At the same time the commission ordered the company to apply within six months for a license under the federal power act for continued operation and maintenance of five existing hydro electric projects on the Klamath in California and Oregon.
 The five projects ruled subject to federal licensing authority were built between 1908 and 1925. They are the Eastside, Westside and Keno in Oregon and Copco No. 1 and Copco No. 2 in California.
