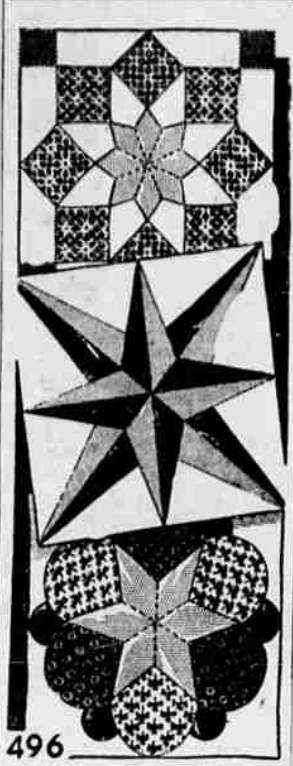
Speaker Warns Of Red Threat

WOODBURN - "That Communism must be contained by force" was the declaration of Rev. Edward Spear, head of Mt. Angel Prep school, who was the guest speaker at the Woodburn Rotary club Thursday noon. Kilian Smith was program chairman. The topic of Rev. Spear was "Why Communism is Attractive," and he stated that one of the basic principles of communism is the elimination of all conflict, which appeals to those who feel they are persecuted. To achieve this communists will use any means and the speaker urged that Americans quit talking and do something. Perfect attendance awards were presented to Oscar Blanchard and Lloyd Fromm for two years; J. F. Lacey, Winton Hunt and T. L. Workman for three years; Edgar Tweed for five years; Lewis Paulson for nine years; H. M. Austin for 12 years; Dr. Gerald B. Smith and Clyde Smith for 16 years. 4. She went to a hospital for treatment. He is in jail.

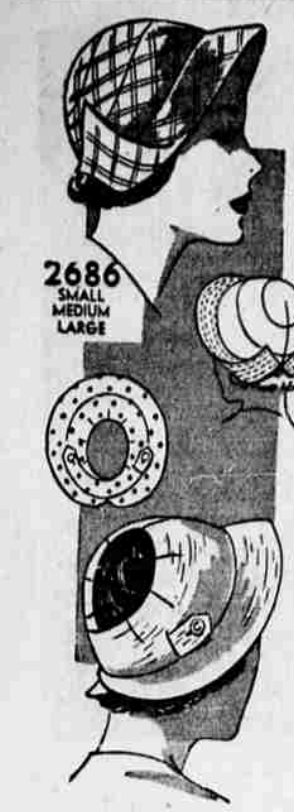

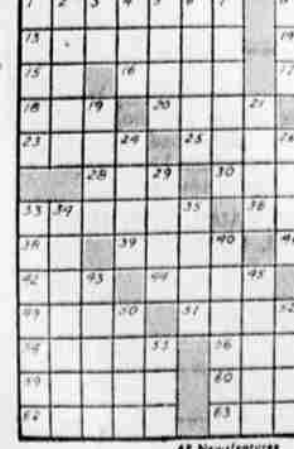
