WOODBURN — Miss Charlene Shaner has just received 60 baby chicks of the White Leghorn variety from the Fred Cockerl hatchery at Milwaukie, Oregon, as the grand champion award at the state fair last fall. It was the Cockerl White Leghorns that made it possible for her to receive this prize, because she was given the same award the previous year.

Miss Shaner expects to exhibit her chickens again at the fall 4-H show for Marion county, and if chosen again, for the state fair. She is beginning her sixth year in 4-H work as an active member and her third year as junior leader. She is the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. C. R. Shaner of Woodburn, Route 2, and an eighth grade student in the McKeen school, and is president of the McKeen health club and junior leader of the McKeen school cooking club.

Miss Shaner is also active in church work. She is pianist for the primary department of the Presbyterian Sunday school at Woodburn and recently received an award for attending Sunday school regularly for her sixth consecutive year.

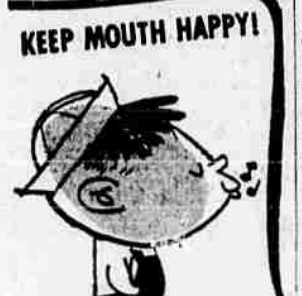
