

Forceps Four Will Try to Retain Crown

FOREST GROVE, Ore.—The biggest barbershop quartet roundup in the nine-year history of Forest Grove's nationally-known songfest will be held this week when the city turns back the clock to the Gay Nineties. Festival dates are February 24-25-26.

More than 30 fourosomes from three states are signed up for three days of close harmony in memory of the good old days. Seventeen men's quartets are registered to date for the two-day male competition on Friday and Saturday. Fifteen petticoat fourosomes will harmonize for the first time on Thursday night at 7:30, in the new women's contest.

Northwest champion ship will be declared, \$1350 distributed among top quartets, and trophies awarded. The Forceps Four from the University of Oregon Medical School, Portland, are the defending champions.

Three thrill-packed days are in store for quartets and the public. The eight male finalists will sing Saturday night at 8:30 PST to the nation over the MBS network. School children and adults will be in costume throughout the festival. Costume and window display contests will be held. A Gay Nineties fair and street parade will be staged on Saturday afternoon. A public oldtime pancake feed, street stunts, and other activities will help bring back the turn of the century.
