### Would Reduce Physical Ed.

SWEET HOME — The Sweet Home Union high school board of directors adopted a resolution to be forwarded to Linn County representatives in the state legislature and education committees in the house and senate asking that the present state law be changed which requires that high school students take four years of physical education except under certain conditions.

This action was taken after members of the board discussed that cutting down on physical education would allow more time for academic subjects. The board also proposed extension to the present three or four rooms for an expanded shop program such as courses in general metal work which would include welding. The addition to the shop building which is a separate unit would greatly increase advantages to students by an increase in variety of courses dealing with shop problems.

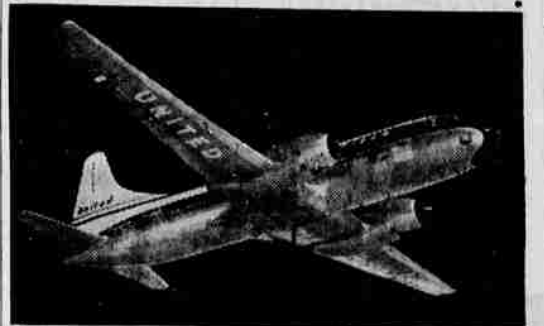
