Fire Department Will Burn Houses for Drill

The Salem Fire Department is looking for houses to burn. No, Not! They're not wanting you to burn down your own home. They want to burn it down for you—that is, if it's in the right location. What they're really looking for, Fire Marshall Glenn Shedeck said, is one or more old houses that the owners are planning on demolishing and are willing to let the fire department do the job by burning the buildings down.

The purpose of the planned burning of such a house or building is for practice drills in extinguishing fires and rescue work for fire department members. The department would set small blazes in the building and then practice various methods of extinguishing them. When the building is burned down, the department will clear away the debris for the owner, he said.

A second use of such a building may be as part of a nation-wide Civil Defense trial — Operation Alert, 1955 — on June 15 and 16. Marion County CD Director W. S. Wharton said the building might be used in a test problem of rescuing "injured" persons from a collapsed or demolished building. Rescue teams from Salem, Lebanon, Eugene, Portland, Forest Grove and The Dalles will participate in such a rescue problem here on June 15, he said.

Such a house need not be in the city limits, Shedeck said, but should be within a reasonable distance as the fire equipment will have to be available for immediate duty in case of fire. The house should be clear of other buildings for at least 100 feet.

Persons with such a building to donate may call Shedeck or fire department Drillmaster Donald Reinke at the fire department office in the city hall.
