Army Lifts Secrecy On Missiles Slightly

HAWTHORNE, Calif. (AP) - An intercontinental guided missile believed capable of carrying an atomic warhead at near supersonic speeds is now undergoing tests. The testing of the missile, called the Snark, is being conducted at Patrick Air Force Base, Fla. The Air Force Monday authorized release of the first pictures of the missile.

These photos were made by Northern Aircraft Inc., which developed the Snark, SM-62. The missile's bullet shaped hull is mounted on thin, swept-back wings. It carries no men but is guided by an electronic brain-type director which also was developed by Northrop.

No details of the missile were disclosed but the photos indicated it was about 40 feet in length with a 30-foot wingspan.

Japan Crowd Hears Graham

TOKYO (AP) - U.S. evangelist Billy Graham Tuesday prayed for Ichiro Hatojama, Christian prime minister of Japan, and later preached the gospel to thousands of Japanese and Americans.

Police estimated 15,000 persons jammed the indoor stadium to sing hymns and hear Graham swear that "the world will blow itself out of existence" unless it bridges a gulf of sin between God and man.

It was the first of two mass meetings Graham has scheduled during a week in Japan.

The newspaper Yomiuri said tears came to Hatojama's eyes as Graham, raved for a proponent of Japan and for the health of the crippled 72-year-old premier. They talked for 30 minutes and Graham offered the prayer at a vigil.

World Health Unit Okays Salk Vaccine

GENEVA (AP) - The U.S. World Health Organization (WHO) reported Tuesday that the American polio vaccine developed by Dr. Jonas E. Salk could now be considered safe for use on a mass scale.

The report by an international group of 12 leading polio experts who met in Stockholm last November, was the first official international approval of the Salk vaccine and similar antipolio serums developed in other countries.

Marines Come Ashore on Iwo Jima During Maneuvers

Thugs Accused Of \$1 Kidnap Soviet Mines Harass Japan

PORTLAND (AP) - Police said Monday Homer Thomas, 17, Los Angeles, charged with the public restroom shooting of a man here Feb. 12, and three other youths have been accused of taking a young Portlander for a ride and leaving him tied and gagged on a golf course.

Thomas, according to Detective Michael O'Leary, admitted shooting Olaf Faloile, 66, in a restroom building attempt. O'Leary said Gary Phelan, 19, Portland, admitted being with Thomas at the time.

Charged with Thomas in the golf course incident are David R. Forrester, 17, Portland; Gary Wayne Mericle, 20, Los Angeles; and Walter P. Clark, 17, also Los Angeles.

According to police Thomas and Forrester admitted they kidnaped William Riley, 17, Portland, Saturday night in a robbery that netted them only \$1.

Woodward Boys Granted \$30,000 To Live On in '56

NEW YORK (AP) - A judge has allowed the late William Woodward Jr.'s two sons - aged 9 and 11 - \$30,000 each for 1956 expenses. Surrogate George Frankenthaler signed an order Monday for the allowances for maintenance, education and support.

Among the listed needs for each of the sons of the millionaire sportsman were \$2,250 for school tuition, \$600 for horseback riding lessons, \$5,000 for travel and expenses and \$2,500 for incidentals.

Austria Will Join Council

VIENNA, Austria (AP) - Austria's government decided Tuesday to join the pro-Western Council of Europe.

The council is an advisory group of representatives of 14 nations and the Saar, formed on parliamentary lines and based in Strasbourg, France. Lacking law-making powers, it considers such things as European unity, economic and cultural affairs.

The government decision was viewed by observers here as a demonstration that Austria, neutral under her independence treaty, regards herself as politically a member of the Western camp.
