WASHINGTON (#)—An election-year farm bill already stripped of rigid price supports for cotton, corn and peanuts faced further rewriting in the Senate today. Democratic proposals to return to higher support levels for wheat and dairy products also were threatened by the 54-41 vote mus-tered by administration support-ers on the initial test. Charges of "deals" and "lobby-ing" interspersed debate as the senators worked until 10:16 p.m. before recessing in a confused tangle over government payments to corn farmers.
