### Plywood Men End Strike at Albany Plant

ALBANY—Pickets will be withdrawn from the Linn Plywood plant, strike-bound since Feb. 21, at 7 a.m. Wednesday, it became known Tuesday through a letter addressed to the Linn Plywood corporation, A. L. Long, general manager, by Herman Schunk, Portland, business agent for Millmen's local, No. 1528.

Affected are more than 200 men who were called out reportedly because of a dispute over discharge of 12 men, who the company charged, had violated their contract by refusing to handle veneer sheets transported from outside the area.

The union had countercharged that the company was guilty of contract violation by discharging the men without giving them a hearing before the plant shop committee. A suit containing such a charge is now pending in U.S. district court at Portland, where it was filed by Schunk.

Local management spokesmen said Tuesday that their policy toward the returning workmen will be influenced by advice of the company's legal counsel but both they and union spokesmen expressed hope that the disagreement can be ironed out satisfactorily to all parties.

### Dates Set for Rose Display

The Salem Rose Society meeting at the YMCA Tuesday night voted to accept an invitation from Gerry Frank to hold this year's rose show in the auditorium of the Meier & Frank store. Dates for the show will be Friday and Saturday, June 22 and 23. Members of the society voted the varieties: Peace and Charlotte Armstrong as the roses to be set apart in special sections in the show.

George Candeaux, Society president, said that the show will be open to entries by any amateur rose grower.

A description of many of the newer rose introductions was given by Fred Edmunds, Jr., of Wilsonville, one of the largest growers of rose plants in the Pacific northwest.

### Phillips Resigns Indian Position To Run Campaign

William L. Phillips today reported that he has resigned as member of a committee of three to supervise the termination of governmental control of the Klamath Indian tribe, due to becoming chairman of Douglas McKay's campaign for the Republican nomination for U.S. senator. The committee was named by McKay as secretary of the interior to carry out public law 587 passed by congress.

Other members of the committee are T. B. Walters, Klamath Falls, chairman, and E. G. Fayell, Lakeview. Planning this transition has now reached its final stage, Phillips said, although carrying out the program will require considerable more time.
